SD-1.1	Master List of Parks & Amenities	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Meeting participants reviewed the master list of all existing amenities located at NFB and Shrewsbury Township Parks to assist with Citizen's Survey brainstorming.</li> </ul>	-
SD-1.2	Brainstorming of Possible Items to be included in the Citizen's Survey	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>ADA Parking – ADA parking should be provided near the park amenities such as the concession stands and band stands.</li> <li>Parking Capacity – There is a need for additional parking, however ADA parking capacity will take precedence over standard parking.</li> <li>Park Circulation – There is a need for better park circulation, especially one that would be mostly ADA compliant. The path could extend around the perimeter of the park and provide a reinforced area for food truck crossing.</li> <li>Bathrooms – There is a need for bathrooms at the park.</li> <li>Drainage Issues – Provide a solution for any existing drainage issues at the park.</li> <li>Relocation of Existing Buildings – Relocate some or all of the existing buildings at the park such as the band stand, concession stands, etc. so they are strategically placed.</li> </ul>	-

		<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Summer/Day Camp – Would the citizen’s have any interest in summer/day camps? What additional certifications would NFB need to acquire?</li> <li>• Skatepark – There has been interest within NFB for a skatepark.</li> <li>• Pool/Splash Pad – There has been interest within NFB for a pool.</li> <li>• Shade for the playground – There has been interest within NFB for shade at the playground. This could include a pavilion, trees, or shade structures.</li> <li>• Athletics/Activities – A grass volleyball court, horseshoe pit, bocce ball, shuffle board, rock wall, or additional playground equipment would all be relatively simple to provide and would consume minimal amounts of open space.</li> <li>• Large Open Pavilion – Incorporate a large open pavilion with the concession stands. It would also be beneficial to provide bathrooms in this location.</li> <li>• Existing Building Consolidation – Consolidate the existing concession areas to one building and add hoods for friers and a fire suppression system.</li> <li>• Upgrade Existing Utilities – Provide electric hookups and/or water hookups for the vendors to set up for events.</li> <li>• Additional Events/Shows – Is there any interest for additional events or shows at the park?</li> </ul>	
SD-1.3	Formatting of the Citizen’s Survey	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• The survey should provide a link or a page listing all of the existing assets/amenities at all existing parks, so citizens are aware of amenities that are currently provided to them.</li> <li>• The survey should be formatted so the citizens can rate options.</li> <li>• Break out the survey by category/sections for organization.</li> <li>• Provide an option for citizens to make a suggestion.</li> <li>• Limit responses to one per household.</li> </ul>	-
